The legacy continues under Racanelli Construction Company, Inc. formed in 1992 by third generation members: Nicholas H. Racanelli, Michael V. Racanelli, Richard M. Racanelli and Martin J. Racanelli, Jr. In 2010, their sister, Constance Racanelli, who initially joined the firm as its corporate counsel, formed a women-owned business enterprise, Con Rac Construction Group.

Still taking an active, consultative role in the company is their father, Martin J. Racanelli, Sr. These companies and a pre-engineered metal building division are constructing diverse buildings, including office/industrial buildings, retail properties, healthcare and educational facilities, storage facilities, hotels and restaurants, houses of worship, pre-engineering buildings and multi-family residential properties. These properties are located throughout the New York-Metropolitan region and along the U.S. eastern seaboard. Among the high profile Racanelli projects recently completed are: the Jacob Javits Convention Center expansion, a new YMCA, multiple Raymond & Flanigan Furniture showrooms, a Hyatt Place Hotel, the Atria Glen Cove Senior Living Community, a luxury condominium building, a state-of-the-art North Shore-LIJ Health System medical imaging facility, and a Community Synagogue.

These projects share in common the Racanelli hallmark of quality construction, achieved through a proven process of vision, pre-construction planning, project management and the provision of comprehensive design/build, general contracting and construction management services. To assure the highest quality, Racanelli employs a proven quality-control process backed by advanced technologies designed to facilitate optimum project management, cost-controls, on-schedule delivery, and worksite safety.

Across the region, the Racanelli brand is well-recognized. The company's principals enjoy strong working relationships within the real estate and construction industry, general business community, financial institutions and local municipalities; relationships built on their professional integrity, quality workmanship, and commitment to their clients.

Additionally, they have actively supported countless other organizations ranging from American Cancer Society, AHRC, Children's Museum of the East End and Contractors for Kids to Hope House Ministries, Leukemia & Lymphoma Society, Literacy Suffolk, Special Olympics and Tomorrow's Hope Foundation.
